

I see what I see not Livetransmission of a gold collision from the STAR-Experiment at Brookhaven National Laboratoy Kunstfassade München 9 by 6 m, November 2004 till March 2005

I see what I see not - Zyklus II

The project "I see what I see not" was awarded in autumn 2004 with the International Media Award of ZKM and SWR for its special relation between science and art in the public space. For the director of the Center for Art and Media ZKM Karlsruhe Peter Weibel the project constitutes a classic example for a *PUSH*-program - a *public understanding of science and humanities*.

In the winter cycle 2004/05 Tim Otto Roth took a more immediate look at the work of scientists concentrating more on raw images and data. During the second winter cycle the experimental results from astrophysics and elementary physics were transmitted in near real time to the facade! The international cooperation partners of this live transmissions were: Max-Planck-Institut für Radioastronomie/DRAO, SOHO mission, Forschungszentrum Karlsruhe, Brookhaven National Laboratory, Stanford Linear Accelerator Center/TU Dresden, Fermilab and the Japanese High Energy Accelerator Research Organisation KEK.
